

RESOLUTION #2021-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WATSON TOWNSHIP, LYCOMING COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO SET ANNUAL FEES FOR SERVICES.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the authority of the Watson Township Board of Supervisors, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of same, that the following fees for services will be in effect for the fiscal year 2021.


1. ZONING PERMIT (NO SITE PLAN)- \$2.00 per \$1,000 of estimated cost, **minimum \$40.00, maximum \$300.00**
2. ZONING PERMIT (SITE PLAN REQUIRED)- \$2.00 per \$1,000 of estimated cost, **minimum \$100.00, maximum \$750.00**
3. VARIANCE HEARING- **\$125.00** (unless exceptional circumstances exist)
4. CONDITIONAL USE HEARING- **\$500.00** (plus any cost to Watson Township above the \$500.00 for attorney fees, stenographer, etc)
5. SPECIAL EXCEPTION HEARING- **\$1,200** (plus any cost to Watson Township above the \$1,200 for attorney fees, stenographer, etc)
6. ORDINANCE VALIDITY CHALLENGE OR REQUEST FOR INTERPRETATION HEARING- **\$125.00**
7. ORDINANCE AMENDMENT AND/OR MAP CHANGE HEARING- **\$125.00**
8. COPY OF ZONING ORDINANCE- **\$10.00**
9. COPY OF FLOODPLAIN OR STORM WATER ORDINANCE- **\$10.00**
10. COPIES OF ANY WATSON TOWNSHIP PAPERS- **\$.25** page
11. DRIVEWAY PERMIT- **\$30.00 low volume, \$50.00 high volume**

12. OVERWEIGHT HIGHWAY PERMIT- Contact Municipal Solutions
13. CUT OR OPEN ROAD MAINTENANCE FEE- **\$2,000** per ditch


